

APPLICATION ifk Junior Fellowship

GENERAL INFORMATION

The ifk Junior Fellowships are intended for young Austrian academics doing their dissertations, as well as for non-Austrian doctoral students who are being supervised at an Austrian university. The applicants must be able to demonstrate they have a Master's degree (or equivalent) and need to be inscribed at a university as PhD students the latest at the beginning of their fellowship.

The dissertation proposal should address an interdisciplinary research project with a focus on cultural
studies. Academic subjects include the humanities,
social sciences and art. A thematic link to the current
research foci of the ifk »Cultures of Translation«
(»Kulturen des Übersetzens«), »Situated in the global«
(»Situiert im Globalen«) or »Different Work« (»Andere
Arbeit«) is not essential, but welcomed. The quality of
the applications is decisive. The detailed research foci

Please NOTE:

The ifk Junior Fellowship requires fluent German at a C2 level. But your project can be either in English or German.
We don't need any language certificates, but the interview will tell us whether the ifk's Junior Fellowship can be followed without any problems.

ifk Junior Fellows receive a monthly scholarship of € 1,650 plus a monthly rent allowance (only upon rent contract and certificate of registration). They will be assigned a work place at the ifk along with internet access and the associated IT equipment. It is necessary, in order to receive the scholarship, to maintain a regular presence at the ifk. It is not possible to be otherwise employed whilst receiving the scholarship, unless this is in a minor capacity. Costs for health and social insurance are not covered by the ifk.

The successful applicant has the option to take part in the ifk grant program for studies abroad, planned for the following academic year (free choice of location and university abroad; participation is possible, but not obligatory).

The final candidates for the ifk Junior Fellowship will be chosen on the basis of an interview. Travel expenses for the journey to these interviews will not be reimbursed.

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

In order to apply, you must fill in the online application form, that is open when the application process starts (usually end of November), and upload **ONE merged PDF** (max. 10 MB) containing all application documents **with your name as the file name:**

Application languages are German and/or English.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

WHICH MUST BE CONTAINED IN YOUR PDF FILE IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Description of the dissertation proposal (**2.000 words maximum**) in German or English with your name and title of the project on the first page.

The project description must contain:

- the project goals, particularly the interdisciplinary aspect
- a description of how the project can be placed within the international research context
- a methodical reflection on how the project goals are to be realized
- 2 A short **project bibliography** (**one page maximum!**). This is not the bibliography of your proposal, but should give an impression of your key references.
- 3 A clear **justification** of why the dissertation should be carried out at the ifk
- 4 An up-to-date **curriculum vitae** with a list of academic publications (if applicable)
- **5** Copies of the degree certificate (scanned)
